ANTI-RAGGING COMMITTEE – ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

The **Anti-Ragging Committee** is responsible for ensuring a safe, harassment-free, and inclusive environment for students. It works to prevent, monitor, and address incidents of ragging in accordance with UGC, AICTE, and other regulatory guidelines.

Roles and Responsibilities

1. Prevention & Awareness

- Conduct **awareness campaigns** (seminars, posters, pledge-taking) about the harmful effects of ragging.
- Ensure that all students, especially fresher's, are informed about anti-ragging laws and institutional policies.
- Include an anti-ragging **undertaking** (as per UGC norms) during admissions from students and parents.

2. Monitoring & Surveillance

- Implement **strict surveillance** in hostels, canteens, common areas, and college premises.
- Appoint **faculty and student representatives** to monitor ragging-prone zones.
- Conduct surprise inspections in hostels, classrooms, and other student gathering areas.

3. Grievance Redressal & Complaint Handling

- Provide **multiple channels** for students to report ragging incidents (grievance box, online portal, email, helpline, etc.).
- Ensure **confidentiality** and protection of the complainant.
- Conduct fair and unbiased **inquiries into reported cases** with proper documentation.

4. Investigation & Disciplinary Actions

- Investigate complaints promptly through a **sub-committee or disciplinary panel**.
- Recommend appropriate disciplinary actions such as **Warning or Counseling** for minor offenses. **Suspension, Expulsion, or Legal Action** for severe cases, as per UGC norms.

5. **Counseling & Support for Victims**
- Provide **psychological and legal support** to victims of ragging.
 - Arrange for professional **counseling sessions** to help affected students.
 - Ensure victims do not face further harassment.
6. **Liaison with Authorities**
- Collaborate with **police, legal authorities, and university bodies** if necessary.
 - Ensure compliance with **UGC, AICTE, and Supreme Court** anti-ragging regulations.
7. **Periodic Reporting & Compliance**
- Submit reports on anti-ragging activities and incidents to the institution and regulatory bodies (IQAC).
 - Conduct annual **review meetings** to improve anti-ragging policies.
